HVRCF Examination of Club Safety and Club Guidelines

True	(check box if true)
	No aircraft will intentionally fly south of the fight line.
	Take-off direction is always into the wind.
	We never taxi aircraft in the pit area.
	It is recommended that all aircraft have active Fail Safe.
	No aircraft will be flown north of the railway tracks.
	A range check is preformed before a model's first flight of the day.
	No aircraft will be armed or started in the shelter area.
	Piston planes will not be flown before 10:00 am.
	All piston planes will be flown with a quiet muffler system.
	Club Dues are to be paid by December 31st for the next season.
	Aircraft will not be flown higher than 300 feet.
	Any aircraft will be grounded if it is too noisy in the air.
	The MAAC Safety Code consists of 23 separate safety documents
