
Humber Valley Meeting Announcement Wed Mar 7th 2018 @ 7:30pm Weston Golf and Country Club

Annual General Meeting (AGM) Report

The club's Annual General Meeting was held on Feb 7th. Reports of the year's activates were presented by the executive which in summary concluded a very successful year for the club. Secretary Danny Karaiskakis presented the minutes of the 2017 AGM which were approved. Treasurer Bruce Gillespie presented the financial statements for last year and the budget for this year which were approved. While the club showed a profit of about \$1500 at last year's AGM, we showed a loss of about the same amount this year. This was attributed to a decline in membership and an increase in the cost of events. Bruce assured the membership that costs would be monitored against the budget this year and if necessary, we may not be able to offer the "on time" renewal fee discount that we have enjoyed over the last several years.

Our current executive agreed to stand for another term with the exception of Peter Poli as Program Director. Tom Gottlieb accepted the nomination to run for Program Director. There were no other nominations for any executive positions so the current executive was acclaimed for 2018 including Tom as Program Director.

Appointed Positions

According to our constitution, the positions of Chief Instructor and Safety Officer are appointed by the executive. For many, many years, Tony Phan has held both positions. Tony has kept us safe and helped many students become accomplished pilots over the years. Tony has always been willing to help



any member with any issue and has always been a passionate supported of the club. We all thank Tony for his years of service and dedication, but we need to give him a break and have made new appointments for this season.


We are pleased to announce that Randall Thomas has accepted the position of Chief Instructor for this season. Randall is a qualified instructor and experienced flyer. He actively instructed last year and quickly gained a reputation for his calm, patient and reassuring approach



with students as well as his excellent flying skills and respect for club rules and safety. Randall would like to make everyone aware of the fact that all new members to Humber Valley (even cleared pilots) must enroll in the Flight Training Program, pass the first two lessons on Field Operations and Safety (Lesson 1) and Aircraft Familiarization and Pre-Flight Check (Lesson 2) and also pass the MAAC Wings Level "A" Test (Lesson 12). Any gualified pilot should be able to do this in about an hour.

We are also pleased to announce that Danny Karaiskakis has accepted the position of Chief Safety Officer for this Season. Danny has been a member since 2011 and as a full scale pilot is well versed in flight safety. He is a passionate supporter of club rules and polices. Danny will provide a presentation on club safety management at the March 7th meeting.
