

## COVID-19 Risk Agreement & Protocols Form

This form must be completed prior to visiting the Humber Valley RC Flyers club airfield (the "Club"). Failure to do so will result in denial of access to the Club. The agreements in this form will remain in effect until the Club Executive declares the requirements in this form are no longer necessary.

Please complete all required fields on the form below and hit the "Submit" button on the bottom of the form. We will record the time, date and IP address of your submission which will constitute your signature. If you are unable to complete the form online, contact the Secretary or any Club Executive to sign and submit a paper copy of the form.

Members of our club could be COVID-19 carriers without any symptoms. There is no certainty that the virus will not be transmitted by any member entering the Club. Further, while the Club Executive is implementing measures prior to re-opening the club to impose health and safety protocols to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus, there can be no assurance that the virus won't be contracted by our members while visiting the Club. This is a risk that each member must assess for themselves, and if they choose to visit the Club, then they have to agree to the possibility of contracting the virus on the Club premises.

## <u>Humber Valley RC Flyers COVID-19 Health and Safety Protocols</u>

The following guidelines apply to members or their guests visiting the club field until further notice:

- 1. No guests except family members living with you are permitted to visit the club.
- 2. Only one member at a time may access the charging station. Arrive at the field with your batteries already charged to minimize charging at the field. Wipe down anything you touch like charging cables before and after use.
- 3. Avoid use of the toilet while at the field as much as possible. If you absolutely must use the toilet, use hand sanitizer to disinfect any surface you touch.

- 4. Bring hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes (or paper towels and at least 70% alcohol) and wipe any common surfaces.
- 5. Minimize touching surfaces and sanitize your hands before and after touching any common surfaces such as the gate lock or charging station lock and equipment.
- 6. Do not leave any form of refuse behind. You must leave with everything that you bring to the field.
- 7. Do not congregate in the shelter, keep a minimum of 2 meters from each other in the pit area at all times, use the designated pilot stations when flying, and keep the same safe distance from each other at the flight line.
- 8. The wearing of masks is still recommended but not strictly required as long as physical distancing is maintained.
- 9. To facilitate contact tracing, logging in at the field is still mandatory so we can determine who has been at the field in case any member contracts the virus. A new Online Field Login Form has been added to the member section of the website. Use your smart phone to quickly post your arrival time at the field and estimate your departure time on the same form. If you do not have a smart phone, ask another member to log you in or use the paper log book in the charging station box. In the latter case, we recommend you use your own pen and sanitize your hands after use.
