2021 Season President's Report



Once again the club has endured a very challenging summer beginning with a province-wide lockdown that closed the field for almost 6 weeks from April 17th to May 25th. Then we were finally allowed to open with a limit of only 5 pilots. We made the best of it and relied heavily on our online booking system that controlled access to the field. Believe it or not, that opening date was about a week ahead of

our early June start in 2020. Slowly but surely, things got better and on June 9th we were able to expand to 10 pilots. Now we are practically wide open with up to 100 people allowed at outdoor gatherings.

So a big thanks from the executive to all members for your patience and understanding during all these changes in rules. Let's hope that the Delta variant currently gaining strength in Ontario will not get the better of us and limit our field operations again. With all this going on, it would still be a good idea to remain cautious and keep your distance from others at the field, especially at our upcoming BBQ event.

In spite of these challenges, we made good improvements to the field this year, the most notable being the upgrade of the charging station described in last month's Flyer. We also installed a number of warning signs at the gate and along the North road and somehow managed to convince the City to regrade the road leading up to our main gate and also on the inside road up to the parking lot.

I am pleased that we are able to schedule the late summer BBQ Fun Fly event for Saturday August 28th. This will be a great time to catch up with friends. The flying has been great this summer so far, but I for one have missed the social interaction with other members because of the restrictions that were forced upon us in the early summer.

Late Summer BBQ Fun Fly - You're Invited!



Great! How Do I Win?

Here's how it will work. The way to increase your odds of winning is by participating as described below to earn as many raffle tickets as you can. The more tickets in the box with your name on them, the greater the chance of your ticket being drawn. But everybody can participate and has a chance to win. Here's how to play and win....

- Show up at the field and show your 2021 Humber Valley member card. As long as you are warm and breathing ...
 Get one raffle ticket.
- Bring any airplane and have at least one flight and land safely in one piece → Get one raffle ticket.
- Crash any airplane ending up with two or more separate pieces - too bad but → Get two raffle tickets!
- 4) Spot land on the runway between the chalk markers verified by any witness → <u>Get one raffle ticket</u>. Note: You can only claim a spot landing ticket once but every time you fly for sport or if you participate in the egg drop contest, you may attempt a spot landing.
- 5) Participate in the egg drop contest → <u>Get one raffle</u> <u>ticket</u>. Win the Egg Drop Contest by hitting closest to the target → <u>Get one raffle ticket</u>.

That's right! All you have to do is give it the old college try and participate and you will increase your chances of winning a prize. When you earn a ticket, just go to the ticket table and claim your ticket from our Raffle Ticket Officer. Write your name and phone number on a raffle ticket and drop it in the box. That's all there is to it! Good luck!

Raffle Draw Rules:

- All tickets earned up to the time of the draw are eligible to win prizes.
- A winning ticket holder may choose any prize that is left.
 So if the 1st or 2nd winner does not want an airplane, he may choose a money prize.
- 3) Only one prize may be won by any member.

So we recommend you label your batteries and charging equipment (and your transmitter) with your name, so that nothing gets mysteriously taken home by another member. Also if you

forget something at the field, there is a good chance you will never see it again unless it has your name on it.

While we are at it, don't forget to make sure your airplanes have a proper MAAC required ID label and always hang your club member and MAAC card on the frequency board.
