

Our constitution requires a quorum of at least 25% of Open Members in order to hold an official AGM, pass the budget for 2024 and conduct executive elections. After the AGM is adjourned, we will open the floor to anyone who wants to show off their latest winter project. You can take 5 or 10 minutes and do your part to inspire others to get building!

How to Prepare for the 2024 Spring Season

Many members have been asking if they will be able to fly this spring at Humber Valley. Even though we are in Controlled Class C airspace, it should be possible to fly "normal" size RC airplanes at Thackeray Park in 2024. While we are cautiously optimistic that Transport Canada will provide us some relief from rules and make it easier for us to fly at Humber in the spring, we cannot rely on that happening. So to be prepared, here are some things you should know and what you can do over the winter to get ready.

- First, you need to understand that to fly under 250g you do not need any RPAS certificate.
- To fly a larger model in UNCONTROLLED airspace you need a RPAS Basic Certificate. You do not need to take a flight test for Basic.
- To fly a larger model at Humber Valley in CONTROLLED airspace you need a RPAS Advanced Certificate. You will need to also take a flight test in the spring to complete your Advanced Certificate after you pass the Advanced exam. We will work on arranging flight reviewers in the spring to help you pass the flight test. Cost will be \$150 to \$200 for the flight review test.
- We are still waiting on MAAC to clarify how we can accommodate student flying with buddy boxes in controlled airspace. We expect to have an answer before the start of the spring season.

If you have trouble logging on to the Member Section, contact Tom Gottlieb. Credentials and password to the Member

Section were sent out previously. It might be a good warm up exercise to take the Basic Exam even though it doesn't help you at Humber. But you can use it to fly at other clubs that are not in controlled airspace.

The following information was sent out to all MAAC members on September 5th, 2023.

If you are interested in taking either Basic or Advanced training, please email Rivka Neal at office@maac.ca and tell her which course you want to take. She will validate your membership, and you will get an email invitation from the RPAS Centre.

The <u>RPAS Centre</u> is an industry-leading <u>RPAS Flight</u> <u>School</u> registered with Transport Canada.

In recognition of MAAC's strong support of RPAS Wilco, the RPAS Centre is making its online <u>Pilot Certificate Exam Prepprogram</u> available to all MAAC members **at no cost**.

Online Basic Pilot Certificate Exam Preparation (No cost for MAAC members. Cost is \$85 for non-MAAC members.)

Online Advanced Pilot Certificate Exam Preparation (No cost for MAAC members. Cost is \$150 for non-MAAC members.)

NOTE:

You don't have to take the course if you want to study all the flight rules yourself and take the exam. The advanced course is 8 – one hour lessons. I know it's a lot of work. It has practice tests etc. You can take your time and do it over the winter. If you want to fly at Humber Valley this spring you have to "put some skin in the game"!

Good luck. We can discuss this at the next meeting at the Northwood Center.

The next 3 sessions are also mid-afternoon from 3:00 to 5:00pm so why not come our and enjoy some great winter indoor flying. Hope to see you there.


Where can I park?
