2024/2025 Winter Waiver Form Request


Update on Indoor Flying at York University

RPAS Wilco Site Survey Updated



CARS Part IX requires that you know how to obtain and understand Site Surveys if you want to fly RPAS models in controlled airspace. Fortunately, based on MAAC NOTAM 2023-04 MAAC - Site Survey Relief Options, new surveys are required only every 56 days. We will do our best to keep a current survey posted on

our website and will let you know through our WhatsApp group when it is updated. A fresh survey was uploaded on Nov 1st and the next one will be on Dec 26th. Here is the schedule:
