GlobalMedic sends Canadian volunteers around the world to aid in the aftermath of disaster and crises. Daniel Cyr is the coordinator for the RescUAV program in Ontario at GlobalMedic. GlobalMedic is a registered Canadian charity, with a mandate is to save lives by providing short-term, rapid response in the wake of disasters and crisis, both at home and abroad.

Dan will speak to us about how his team uses advanced and innovative drone technology to provide:

- · Aerial imagery of disaster affected buildings,
- Thermal imagery to locate survivors,
- Ground Penetrating Radar technology to scan collapsed buildings and detect signs of human life.

This will be a one-of-a-kind talk that you don't want to miss. It is a unique example of how drone technology can be used in a positive way to help people and save lives. There are teams of volunteers all across Canada and they can be deployed at a moment's notice to go anywhere in the world to join Canada's aid response teams. Dan will speak about his two recent deployments; the Guatemala Volcano eruption in June 2018 and the Earthquake/Tsunami in Palu Indonesia in October.

open if you do not scramble the numbers! The gate lock shank should be interlocked with the City's lock so that either lock will open the chain. Finally, please do not disclose the lock combination or web site member password to any non-member.

## **MAAC Policy Requires Airplane ID Labels**

We told you in the October Flyer about MAAC's new policy that requires you to mount an identification label on all models. MAAC policy permits the information to be on the inside or outside of the aircraft. You can use clear Scotch tape to laminate it on your airplane. You can make your own label or cut out the sample below. Please note that going forward, any member of the club's executive committee will ground your plane for the day if you cannot demonstrate that you have labeled your aircraft correctly. We will bring a supply of blank labels to the November 7<sup>th</sup> meeting that you can use. Please label your aircraft!
