



#### **Annual General Meeting Report**

The club's Annual General Meeting (AGM) was held on Feb 3<sup>rd</sup> and we had a good turnout with more than enough members and proxies to constitute a quorum. Reports of the year's activates were presented by the executive which in summary concluded a very successful year for the club. Bruce Gillespie, Treasurer presented the financial statements for last year and the budget for this year.

Bruce Gillespie reported on the investigation of a possible second air strip within the Thackery Park conservation area. The City plans to dump 1,000 to 2,000 truckloads of dirt on the east slope of the dump to prevent leaching of hazardous waste which has the potential of becoming an alternate flying site that would complement our present field layout. In the event that we secure permission from the city to use this area for a second airstrip, Bruce presented a motion to allow for an extraordinary expenditure as follows:

The Club is authorized to make and expenditure of up to \$4,000 from the Club reserves. This expenditure would not be part of the current year expense budget but treated as an extraordinary item which can be spent in 2016 or in a later year when it is required. The money is to be used for the surfacing the proposed new runway.

The pros and cons of the potential airstrip and costs were discussed at the meeting and the motion passed by the members. The budget with this extraordinary item was subsequently passed.

With the exception of the position of President, all current executives agreed to stand for another term and were acclaimed. **Paul McMillan** decided to step down as President. Paul has given so much to the club since 2012 when he was first elected and he will continue to advise us as Past President. Paul nominated **Val Oddo** to succeed him as President. Val provided some background on his interests and

history with RC flying and especially his focus on safety and the social aspects of the club as members welcome and help other members improve their skills. In the short few years as a Humber member, Val became an active participant in the student instruction program and participated in IMAC competitions for the first time. Val was elected to the position of President by a unanimous vote. Please get to know Val and help him in any way you can by volunteering and supporting club events.

#### **Club Program Announcement - March 2nd**

### **Workshop on Static and Dynamic Balancing** of Props and Motors ... Milton Charlton

Milt has been investigating the impact of proper balancing. Anything that spins can cause vibration and impacts the performance of your model. Turns out (no pun intended) that there is a lot more to it than you think.

First, we will have demonstrations of static balancing of props. Please bring any propeller and your favourite prop balancer and demonstrate your method of balancing. Remember to bring sandpaper, glue or other materials to adjust the prop.

Especially needed is a demonstration of how to balance big wood or carbon props and how to balance 3 and 4-blade props.

Second, we will have a demonstration of three techniques to measure the balance of electric motors. Then we will try to balance one.

Third we will we will use these techniques to measure the vibration of a spinning prop/motor/spinner combination to assess their balance.





There are dozens of techniques and balancers out there. Some are simple, some complex, all ingenious. Bring in your equipment to demonstrate.
