

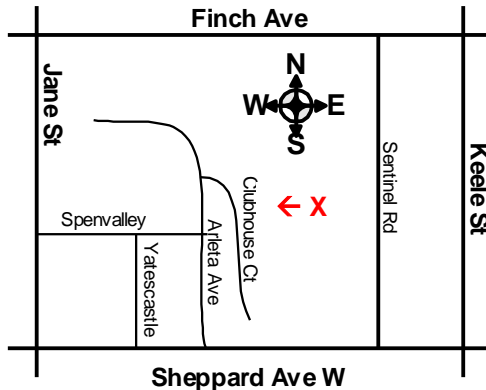


## Humber Valley Meeting Announcement

## April 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting Program Announcement How to Fly (and Land) in Wind



Last summer there were many days with strong wind at our field. You might as well face facts. If you are afraid of a breeze, you will miss out on a lot of good flying while learning to handle a stiff breeze will greatly increase your enjoyment of the hobby.

Come to the April meeting to learn and try your hand at flying on a simulator that is set up for cross wind flying and landing. This session will include a demonstration and tutorial about how to fly in the wind. We will start by viewing projected videos of commercial planes taking off and landing in crosswinds accompanied by commentary from pilots on how it should be done. Then we will use a RealFlight simulator with projector to demonstrate how crosswind takeoffs and landings are done with various RC planes. The expert pilots can then give hints to less experienced pilots as they try to manage wind. Finally we will test the limits of landing expertise by steadily increasing wind velocity and turbulence. Who can get it down? ... Don't miss this fun evening and learning experience.
