


Humber Valley Meeting Announcement

A number of members have been inspired by challenge, fun and success I achieved at IMAC last year resulting in increased participation by Humber Valley club members in IMAC events in 2015.

In Ontario we had 4 contests this season and I was able to attend all of them. HVRCF was probably the best represented club at Ontario contests this year. We had **Domenic Teti**, **John Neves**, **Val Oddo** and **Shaobo (Michael) Lei** and I all compete in IMAC this season. Domenic moved up to Sportsman class this year and finished in second place for Ontario points. If he had not had ignition trouble at the regional championship in Saranac, MI he very likely would have finished in third place for the North Central region. John Neves attended three contests and finished in second place for Ontario Basic class points. Shaobo got first place in Basic class at his first IMAC

contest. Val did very well at his first contest and I'm sure he will be back for more. I finished in first place for Ontario points in Sportsman class and second place for the North Central region.



I have really enjoyed adding IMAC scale aerobatics to my hobby and I'm glad to have others from HVRCF join in the fun. I think Domenic and I will both move up to Intermediate class for next season.



There was a US / Canadian added challenge this season for the IMAC North Central Region. They created the "America's Cup" which used the highest raw scores from one contest in the USA and one contest in Canada. The US won in June in Saranac, MI and Canada won in August in Sault Ste. Marie. Domenic is in possession of this trophy and I have asked him to bring it for show and tell.
