



Scratch Built Turbo Beaver

Tom Gottlieb brought in a new Turbo Beaver to the December meeting which was scratch built by Steve Szekely who retired from De Havilland about 10 years ago after working there for nearly 30 years in the machine shop. Steve used to build wind

tunnel test models for De Havilland and when he retired, started building Beavers and other airplanes from the original De Havilland plans. This one is modeled after a real Turbo Beaver shown above sporting an Inuit Raven art paint scheme.





"When I saw this Beaver hanging at RC Sports and Hobbies, I just knew I had to have it!" says Tom. "I had been looking for a real float plane after a less than happy performance at the summer float fly with planes that frankly were never meant to get wet. Can't wait to maiden it in the spring."
