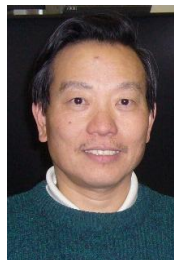
provided by the club. Bring out your favorite flyer as we plan to have numerous fun events and lots of prizes.

- Have a pilot meeting at 10 o'clock to review safety
- Enforce a flying circuit direction
- Enforce a 5 airplane limit at one time
- Assign safety monitors with authority to ground any flyer

Humber Valley Helps Summit Middle School

We reported this project to you in the March 2012 Flyer and now we can tell you the results of the Summit Middle School Glider Flying Competition. School teacher **Damien Mendez** is the Director of the H.S. Entrepreneur's Club at the school. It was his idea to hold a competition for students to design and build hand launched model gliders with prizes for the best designs. Damien came to one of our winter meetings and asked for our support. Humber Valley is pleased to help any worthwhile community project that promotes the idea of model building and flying.



Three of our members attended to judge the competition on Friday June 8th and provided a RC flying demonstration for the students. **Jon Holmes, Jeff Shimo, and Zoltan Pittner** showed their flying skills. Zoltan flew his Quadra Copter, and Jon flew his Russian fighter and another coroplast plane. Jeff also flew an electric fun fly model. The event was sanctioned by MAAC for insurance coverage.

About 70 students tried their skill with gliders competing for prizes for furthest flying distances. **Ernie Dawson**, Field Officer assisted the teacher, **Damien Mendez** by acting as a distance judge, measuring with a tape. In spite of the windy conditions, all seemed to have a good time.

Locking the Gate – Policy and Guidelines

Our Field Officer **Ernie Dawson** wants to remind everyone about the importance of locking the gate and to note the proper locking connection.

We are very happy that the city has provided us with a new gate that secures the field during off hours. However, often the gate is not properly locked or left open. It is the responsibility of the last member who leaves the field to lock the gate. There are two locks secured to the chain. The combination lock is ours and the key lock is the City's. When you lock the gate, you must connect the two locks together as shown in the picture so that opening either lock will open the chain.



Please also follow these other tips.

1. When you lock the gate, spin the numbers to hide the combination. They do not spin on their own.
2. When you open the gate, close and lock our lock to the fence to prevent anyone from stealing the open lock while the gate is open.
3. If you are the 2nd or 3rd last member to leave the field, please remind the remaining flyers, that it is their job to lock the gate when they leave.
4. Finally as stated above, intersect the City lock with ours and spin the numbers when you lock the gate.

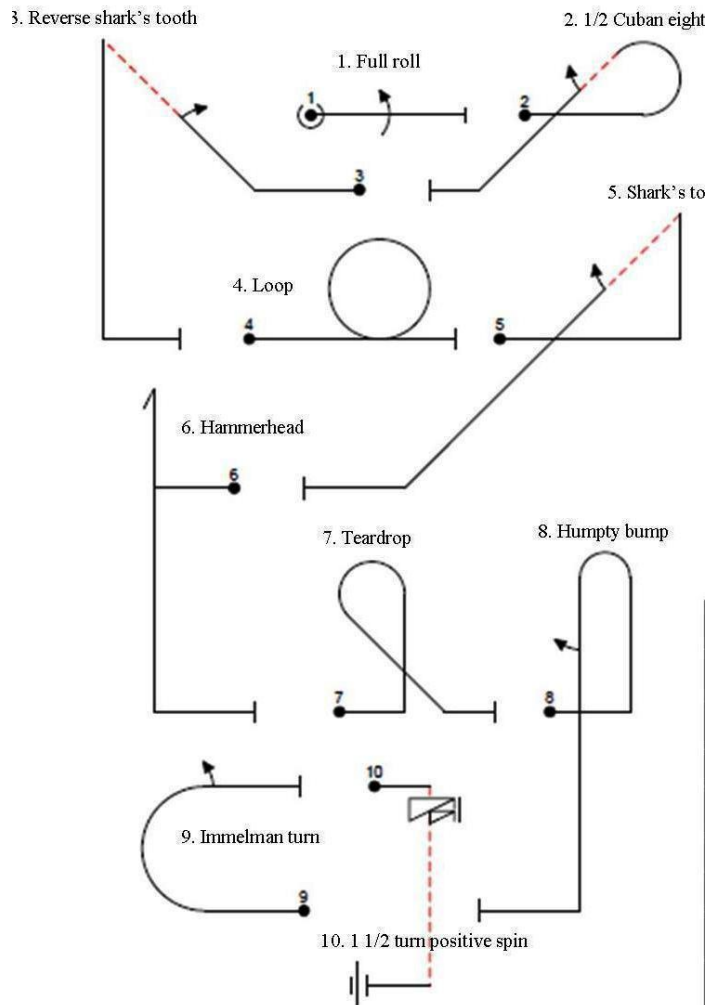


IMAC BASIC Competition – Just for Fun!
