

Humber Valley Noise Discussion (Cont'd)

A number of members and executives have been testing their engines over the last few months and have made significant progress using "snuffler" extensions designed to silence the big gas engines. For questions about this, visit the club forum or talk to Tony Phan. The Humber Valley new noise policies and rules will be the top priority of the new executive after the elections at the February meeting. Stay tuned for more information in the coming months.



At the present time, there doesn't seem to be any reason not to adopt the rule described in the December Flyer. Based on recommendations from the IMAC Sound Task Force (STF), we are testing planes at a distance of 25 feet. The decision to use 25 feet as a benchmark is based on repeatable measurements made by the STF. It turns out that 88 decibels at 25 feet is equivalent to 96 decibels at 10 feet at 3 ft height with an "A" weighted scale.

INDOOR FLYING ARRIVES AT HUMBER

Humber's first unofficial indoor flying took place on Saturday Jan 23rd at North Albion C. I. from 3:00pm to 5:00pm. Six pilots including Gary Del Bel Belluz, Dave Edwards, Eric Gallas, Paul McMillan, Dan Paluzzi and Rocco Vita (see photo below) challenged the basketball nets with a variety of small electric indoor craft ranging from the tiny E-flite Vapor to the lumbering Troll. Much fun and aggravation was had by all and we look forward to the next session on Feb 6th. Anyone wishing to join us is welcome. HVRCF and MAAC membership is a must. Indoor fixed wing electrics and micro/mini helicopters are allowed. It is yet to be determined if there will be a cost to members who wish to participate, since at the time of printing, the 2009-2010 budget has not vet been approved. Our cost per session is \$49, so if there is a cost to members, it will be between \$5 and \$10 depending on the number of people that show up.
