MAAC Execs Visit December Meeting

Humber Valley had some surprise visitors at the December meeting. Humber Valley Life member and MAAC President Richard Barlow attended along with long time friend and newly appointed Southeast Ontario Zone Director Clair Murray. What a treat to have our very own Zone Director and President attending. Clair introduced himself and openly invited anyone to contact him for any issue in the SE Ontario Zone and encouraged participation in MAAC meetings and events. The meeting carried on with the usual heated debate and discussion on the hot topic of the day - noise control. "If you wait too long to deal with noise problems, you risk loosing your field." said Richard Barlow. "By the time you get your first complaint, it may well be too late."

Humber Valley Noise Discussion Cont'd

The discussion on appropriate and acceptable noise limits has continued relentlessly since the December meeting. A number of members and executives have spent considerable time at the field experimenting with different props, mufflers and "snufflers" and much progress has been made. It now appears perfectly reasonable to attain modest noise levels even with large gas engines. After the new executive is in place for 2010, we will formally adopt the new noise guidelines and update the club's safety rules. At the present time, there doesn't seem to be any reason not to adopt the rule described in the December Flyer.

Based on recommendations from the IMAC Sound Task Force (STF), we are testing planes at a distance of 25 feet. The decision to use 25 feet as a benchmark is based on repeatable measurements made by the STF. It turns out that 88 decibels at 25 feet is equivalent to 96 decibels at 10 feet at 3 ft height with an "A" weighted scale.

Therefore, the club has acquired a high quality TES 1351 sound meter (shown right) and has been testing planes this month. The meter is very easy to use and we have laid out distance markers in a circular pattern west of the pits. The concrete markers will make it easy to take a downwind decibel reading regardless of wind direction. If you want your plane tested, call Tony Phan and meet him at the field. Due to the cold weather, he can only do sound tests by appointment. When the temperature warms up, we can do tests anytime Tony is at the field which is almost every day!



Check in with what is happening on the club's forum for latest tips and tricks. If you need help, post a question and you are sure to get the help you need to solve your noise issues.
