Many thanks to **Paul Fleming** who presented a very interesting slide show and discussed what it takes to build

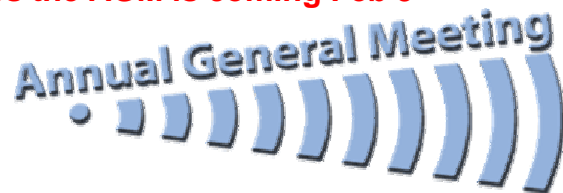
