


Humber Valley's Meeting Announcement Tues Mar 4th, 2008 @ 7:30pm

Show and Tell at the March Meeting



Safety Tip of the Month

Safety should always be top of mind when you are at the field. With spring around the corner, here are **Peter Heeley's** tips about gas engine starting safety that we should all remember.

- First, focus your attention entirely on what you are doing and retain that.
- 2) Ensure aircraft is securely restrained.
- 3) No smoking around the aircraft, fuel etc.
- 4) Other persons should be behind the propeller arc.
- 5) Transmitter at hand to control throttle.
- 6) Set throttle to low idle for engine start.
- 7) Start engine with stick or electric starter. No bare fingers.
- 8) Upon engine start, move transmitter behind the propeller.
- Remove glow driver and make all adjustments from behind the propeller.
- 10) No reaching over or around the propeller arc.

As a general rule, propellers bang your knuckles when hit from behind. From the front they pull you in and cut. From the side they slice. Treat your engine and prop with the respect they deserve!
