Field Officer Report - Gary Del Bel Belluz

Our field officer Gary Del Bel Belluz provided an update of field activities at the October meeting. Here are the highlights of his report.

- The lock on the first aid box has been replaced with a combo lock, combo is written under the box.
- The city is planning a cricket pitch near the entrance gate but the project is on hold until next year so I don't have any more info. The leveled area inside the gate is approx. 400' x 250' and will provide an alternate winter flying field if the gravel road is blocked with ice and snow. A small frequency board utilizing clothes pegs will be mounted inside the gate. Next year the gate will be moved to allow unrestricted access to the cricket pitch while protecting access to the top of the hill.
- Mowing Team Update: The grass never stopped growing this summer and we were fortunate to have a dedicated crew of 14 people looking after the field maintenance. Great job Grass Cutting Team (see below)!!
- The club also wishes to thank Barry McCallister from the Etobicoke Parks Department for filling in the wet spot in the pit area. The new grass has already been mowed and Barry plans to run some drainage pipe under the area next year.
- Tractor/Mower Update: It's time for new a new mower! Our Cub Cadet is over 3 years old and shows 250 hours on the Hobbs meter. There were several mechanical breakdowns this summer with repairs costing more than \$500. Dan Paluzzi and I are currently evaluating models from 3 manufacturers; Gravely, Kubota and John Deere. A commercial mower offers several advantages including: high speed, greater maneuverability and increased towing capacity.
