



NIBLETT COTTAGE DIRECTIONS LAKE ROSSEAU, MUSKOKA (705) 765-7488 1552 JUDDHAVEN ROAD

- Take Hwy 400 north from Toronto
- Continue on Hwy 400 to 400 extension ie Hwy north to Parry Sound (goes off to the right just north of Barrie then crosses over top of Hwy 11)
- Take 400 extension north to Hwy 69 which goes off to the right Exit 189
- Continue on Hwy 69 north to Foots Bay (approximately 8 km)
- Just before the town of Foots Bay, (<u>not</u> the sign that says Foots Bay) take Hwy 169 South to Gravenhurst (which goes off to the right)
- Stay on 169 South to Gravenhurst for approximately 10 km to Hwy 118 (118 South to Bracebridge)
- Turn left onto 118 (South to Bracebridge) and take for approximately 5 km to road No. 7
- Road 7 or Min. Road 7 is called Peninsula Road
- Turn left onto Peninsula Road and take for 10 km (through Port Sandfield cross a one lane swing bridge) to the very little town of Minett (don't blink!)
- At Minett turn right (only way you can turn the Corner Store will be right in front of you) onto the Juddhaven Road
- From that right turn the cottage is 6.2 km along the Juddhaven Road (note that the road makes a sharp left turn 500 meters after you have turned onto the Juddhaven Road going straight you will end up at Clevenlands House reception area)
- Getting close to the cottage, approximately 5.8 km along Juddhaven Road you will go down a hill and at the bottom there will be on the left (just off the road) a small Lodge with a white fence (which is gone now a big hole in the ground however, parts of the fence are still there) and immediately to the right you will see the lake approximately 10 meters away
- Then you will go up a hill, go slow because the cottage is at the top on the right -light green double car garage with a large white garage door/ crush stone driveway with large rocks on either side THAT'S IT! 1552 JUDDHAVEN RD. & GOOD LUCK!

IF YOU HAVE A GPS – JUST PLUG IN THE ADDRESS AND IT WILL BRING YOU RIGHT TO THE DRIVEWAY.
