



# Gary's Update on Field Leveling Progress

The first loads of clean fill have been delivered to the area west of the gate. Soil will be dumped there as it becomes available. When enough is accumulated, the Parks Department will haul it up the hill and fill in the depressions on the north half of the flying field. The one mound of fill in the center of our field marks the east / west boundary for leveling operations. The inconvenience to landing and take-off should be minor. We really are fortunate to have so much green
