



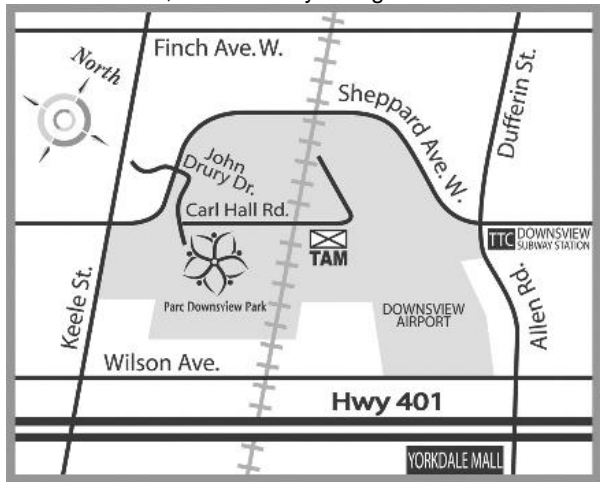

The April 4<sup>th</sup> meeting was well attended and **Nelson Jacinto** presented his impressive Bell 47G gas Helicopter. **Terrence and James Allen** also brought in an ambitious project they have completed just in time for spring flying. It's a twin .60 powered OV-10 Bronco, weighing in at about 18 lbs from Scaletech ARF and distributed by Hobby Hanger. It has an 80.5" span. This rugged, maneuverable, multi-mission aircraft served the U.S. Air Force and Marine Corps in the late 1960's.



Whichever way you look at it, there will be some interesting aircraft flying at Humber Valley this summer.

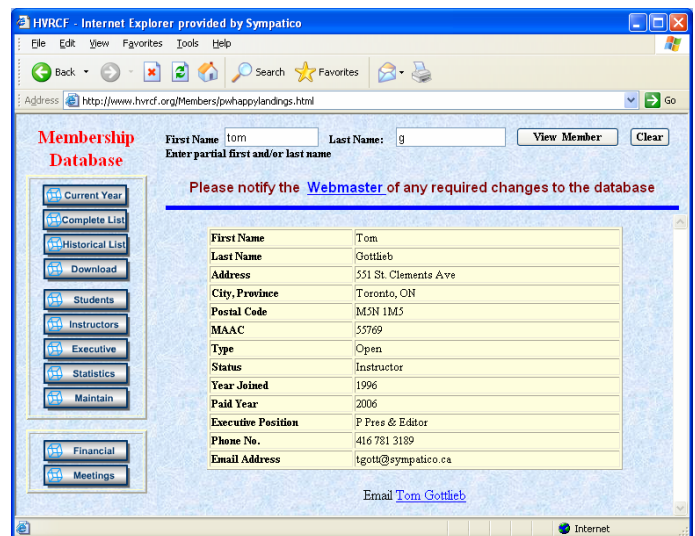
