
Please note the following directions and study the map carefully. If you have never been there, it can be a little tricky finding

Here's how to the get there: From the 401 East or West, exit at Keele Street North. Turn right on Sheppard Ave, and follow Sheppard to the entrance to Downsview Park. Turn right into the park onto John Drury Lane until you reach Carl Hall Road. Turn left at Carl Hall and continue east over the railway tracks to the Museum, which is on your right hand side.



Motions and Correction

The following motions were **passed** virtually unanimously at the October meeting and will be updated in the constitution. Motion #3 had an incorrect start date of September 1st. This is corrected below:

Motion #1: Change Article 2.1 Elections to:

Officers of the Club shall be elected each year at the annual general meeting.

Motion #2: Change Article 3.2 Annual Meetings to:

The Annual General Meeting shall take place at a location, time, and date chosen by the Executive and shall be held within six months of the end of the fiscal year.

Motion #3: Change Article 4.1 Financial Year to:

The fiscal year shall be November 1st to October 31st.

Oct 7th Meeting Report:

Thanks to Bob Burke for putting on a great talk on what it takes to become a recreational ultralight pilot and about his experiences building the Hummelbird. We'll have to track this project and let you know how the maiden flight works out next year. Of special interest to members was the correlation between Bob's experience and our own RC world. Bob told us about those rare "Character Building" experiences when there is nothing between you and tragedy except your instinct and skill. Anyone who has flown RC for a while has had a few of those heart throbbing moments.

Thakeray Park Construction Update

There is lots of construction activity around our field (Thakeray Park) these days. You may have noticed the temporary road running across the front of our shelter. This is for equipment access to the north side of the railway line. Sewer and roadwork will be ongoing in that area into next year. There is a major sewer line installation under way on the north side of Steeles Ave. It starts at the pump house under the Humber Bridge and runs west to Martin Grove. Many trees and shrubs were removed in the process making our parking area and shelter much more visible from Steeles Ave. This should help visitors locate the field. There is also a large senior's complex going up about half a kilometer west of the field. Hopefully the remainder of those lands will be developed into low commercial buildings. The field itself is still covered in a thick carpet of grass so make sure your wheels aren't too small. Grass cutting and toilet service stops at the end of October.
