





#### **Election Process Changes Proposed**

Your club executive, after extensive discussions over the summer, has determined that a few minor changes to the constitution are in order, to allow the election process to better serve the needs of the club, and keep a vibrant and effective executive in place. The current rule of electing part of the executive every two does not work well in practice, and causes general confusion each year about which positions need to be filled or replaced. Often an executive chooses to hold office for one or three years, throwing off the two year cycle.

Consequently, we feel that all officers of the club should be elected annually, rather than every two years, in order to simplify the election process and encourage member participation in club governance. Having a full slate of elections every year will not necessarily mean that the entire executive will change every year. Any executive wishing to continue in office may automatically run for re-election.

Therefore the following motion will be put to vote at the next general meeting on October 7<sup>th</sup>.

#### Be it resolved that Article 2.1 Elections, of the by-laws which reads:

Officers of the Club shall be elected each year at the annual general meeting according to the following schedule:

In odd years, elections are held for the offices of vicepresident, treasurer, contest director and junior representative. In even years elections are held for the offices of president, social convener, secretary and field officer. Elected officers assume office immediately. Appointed positions are reviewed and determined annually by the Executive Committee.

#### Be changed to:

Officers of the Club shall be elected each year at the annual general meeting.

#### **Annual General Meeting Change Proposed**

In addition to the above change, two other minor changes are needed in order to allow us enough time to plan for proper election procedures. Currently the November meeting is designated as the Annual General Meeting (AGM) when elections are to be held and when the treasurer's annual budget and report should be presented. Since the first winter meeting is the first week of October, there is not enough time to properly nominate candidates, nor is there enough time to prepare a good financial report to the end of the operating year to October 31st since the November meeting occurs only one week later.

The Ontario Corporations Act stipulates that a corporation's AGM must occur within 6 months of the fiscal year end. Consequently, the executive feels the needs of the club would be better served by adopting the following two motions.

Be it resolved that Article 3.2 Annual Meetings, of the bylaws which reads:

The Annual General Meeting shall be the regular November meeting.

#### Be changed to:

The Annual General Meeting shall take place at a location, time, and date chosen by the Executive and shall be held within six months of the end of the fiscal year.

And Article 4.1 Financial Year, of the by-laws which reads:

The fiscal year shall coincide with the Annual General Meeting.

#### Be changed to:

The fiscal year shall be September 1st to October

## Vote will be held at the Oct 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting

Please make sure you register your vote on these three motions. The club executive unanimously recommends you vote in favor of all motions. The vote will be held at the Oct 7th meeting following any discussion or questions on the motions. You can vote in one of three ways:
